

Invitation to shape the plans for our next mental health hospital

In 2009 we agreed to develop three new mental health hospitals for people living in Surrey and north east Hampshire.

We have recently completed the first of these new state-of-the-art hospitals with therapeutic surroundings that aid recovery at Farnham Road Hospital in Guildford.

Following changes in mental health over the last few years, including significant investment in early intervention and more support services treatment in or close to people's homes, we are now considering whether two hospitals will meet local needs.

We are at the start of the process to develop plans for a second hospital and would like to hear from local people to shape our plans for mental health services in Surrey and north east Hampshire.
