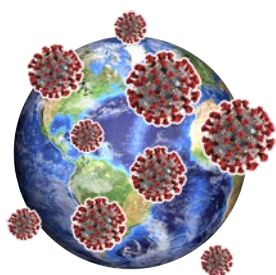


Tell us about your health and social care services during the Coronavirus crisis
