How our Healthwatch volunteers have made a difference:

Jane and Janice were part of a team of volunteers who participated in a series of 'enter and view' visits into care homes. looking at how residents were treated as individuals. During one visit Jane and Janice raised serious concerns about the standard of hygiene and consequently we reported their findings to the Care Quality Commission (CQC). Two days later the CQC inspected the care home and rated the home as inadequate in 4 domains which led to enforcement action. The home has since been closed and the residents have moved into other homes.

If Jane and Janice hadn't volunteered for Healthwatch Surrey, the residents would still be living in unhygienic conditions.
